

**Okumusashi Hiking**  
**Saturday, 27 November 2021**  
**Depart: 0600/Return: 1800**



Our first 60-minute will be a steep uphill climb all the way to the Take (bamboo) Temple. You will go through the tori gate with a chinowa ring and take a look at the Buddha statue which is only open to the public once every 12 years. You will keep climbing an additional 95 minutes to reach the Tenryuji Temple where the huge straw sandals are enshrined. You will test your leg muscles and descend about 25 minutes to the Asami hut where you can enjoy the local specialty, Musashino Udon. The last 40 minutes will be a gentle downhill to our goal, Togo Park. You will be able to see maple trees full of the autumn colors.

Tobu Zoo Park in Saitama prefecture combines a zoo with an amusement park in an effort to offer something for everyone. The amusement park provides more than 30 kinds of attractions from scary to heartwarming rides.

## Lake Kameyama Hiking & Afternoon Tea Thursday, 11 November 2021 Depart: 0500/Return: 1800



Let's enjoy hike from Sasagawa Lake to Kameyama Lake. The first 40 minutes will be an ascent on paved road to Mitsuishi Kannon Temple, which is famous for its huge rocks. Okuno-in Hall is located on the top of the rocks. You may climb up the rocks to tie your handkerchief to wish for a good relationship. After the 50 minute downhill walk, you will arrive at our goal, Lake Kameyama. The lake has a total of 25 bridges over it, we will cross six of them. Enjoy lunch, then we will head to the rose garden to admire beautiful roses and relax with having afternoon tea!

## Torii Kannon Hike Saturday, 13 November 2021 Depart: 0700/Return: 1530



Enjoy walking on the small peak, Mt. Hakuun. The entire mountain is the Torii Kannon Temple site and a 23-meter high Kannon statue is set on the top of the mountain. You will be able to see Oriental style religion buildings while walking. The trails to the Kannon statue will be very steep (average angle value is 17 degree!), but only takes 40 minutes. There are steps inside of the Kannon stature. Pay 200yen to enter and enjoy the whole view of Okumusashi Mountains from the observatory.

## Mt. Oyama Hiking Saturday, 20 November 2021 Depart: 0530/Return: 1700



Let's climb Mt. Oyama, the largest mountain you can see from Camp Zama. First, we will hike on 382 stone steps to the cable car station. Then, hike through the "Men's slope" for 30 minutes and arrive at Afuri Lower Shrine. From the shrine there is a 45-minute walk along a flat trail and a 45-minute steep ascent to a ridge where you will continue to hike for another 25 minutes towards the Afuri Upper Shrine, the summit of Mt. Oyama. You might be able to run across wild deer while hiking. After a 60-minute descent, we will hike along the "Women's slope" to visit Oyama Temple. About 20 minutes from Oyama Temple is the cable car station and the 382 stone steps. Enjoy souvenir hunting at the Spinning Top Approach! >>>Mt. Oyama: 1,251m/4,104ft, 7.2km/4.47mi, 5 hour, Max elevation 938m/3,077ft.

## Stroll Ashikaga Town Sunday, 21 November 2021 Depart: 0700/Return: 1900



We will stroll through Ashikaga town to visit shrines and temples considered as power spots. Our first destination will be Isoyama Bente Shrine, which is famous for its impressively clear spring water pond located at the entrance of the shrine. The main approach to the inner shrine will be 130 stone steps. You can climb the steps to wish for the economic fortune. After visiting Isoyama Bente, we will ride a bus to Ashikaga area. We will visit Bannaji Temple, which used to be the mansion of Ashikaga family, then we will walk about 15 minutes to a shrine which is the only shrine that issues "BIJIN SHOUMEI (Beauty Certification)". Get one or more for yourself, families and friend, then head to the last destination, Orihime Shrine where the god of textile is enshrined. You have two ways to get to the main building; climb the well-maintained 229 steep steps to wish for the dream comes true, or climb on narrow off-road through seven colors Torii gates to wish for the good relationship.
