

Yokoya Gorge Hiking

Avoid heat and enjoy walking on the trail at plateau. Yokoya gorge is created by erosion of Shibu river and 6km hiking trails are set along the river. You will be able to see dynamic waterfalls while hiking. To the first waterfall from the parking lot will be 10 minutes walk. If it is sunny, you will be able to see a rainbow around the waterfall. Walk about 10 minutes, second waterfall will be seen. Keep walking as watching strange shape rocks for 30 minutes, then ascend steep uphill for 15 minutes, you will arrive at Yokoya Kannon Temple. Take a break, then get back to the trail by the river to see the highlight of the trail, the two stories waterfall. Pass the last waterfall and cross the Shibu River, and go toward our goal, the mysterious pond, Mishaka.

>>>Approximately 6km/3.73mi, 2 hours, Max elevation 353m/1158ft.

Stroll Mishima Sunday, 07 August 2022 Depart: 0700/Return: 1730



Let's stroll the waterfront city, Mishima! It is located at the south side of the foot of Mt. Fuji and has an abundant of underflow water from the mountain. Our hike starts from a shrine where 80 red Torii are lined up. In a residential area, 5 minutes from the shrine, is a huge waterfall. Take this opportunity to take photos of the waterfall and Mt. Fuji together if the weather is clear. 30 minutes from the waterfall is a Japanese garden which is designated as a natural treasure. Walk through the park and see the lava formation caused by the eruption of Mt. Fuji 10,000 years ago. Next, we will walk on a trail along Genbei River for 15 minutes. Take off your shoes and soak your feet in the limpid stream. Return on a paved road and keep walking until we arrive at the heart of Mishima, the Mishima Shrine. >>>Approximately 5.6km, 2.5 hour walking. (Almost flat)

***It is for ages 6 and up.**

***There is possibility that the trails in the river go under water in the thawing season (Summer). In that case, we will walk in the river.**

Wear: Comfortable shoes to walk/easy to get on and off, Short pants, Cap/hat.

Bring: Rain gear, Sunscreen, Sunglasses, Marine shoes/Crocs® Sandals/Shoes you do not mind getting wet, Towel, Water/snacks, change of clothes, (Water bottle to bring spring water home), Yen for lunch and anything you may need.

Kirigamine Hiking Saturday, 20 August 2022 Depart: 0400/Return: 1830

Kirigamine is a plateau spread at the altitude 1,600m. Hike around Kirigamine, where 10C/50F cooler than Camp Zama. We will start walking from Kurumayama-kata for a 40-minute moderate ascent to the top of Kurumayama. Following 45 minutes will be going up and down until Chocho Miyama Summit. Keep going down for an hour, you will get to the huge marsh where 400 kinds subalpine plants can be seen. Walk around the marsh for 25 minutes, you will arrive at the marsh parking lot. Remaining will be one-third of the trail, about 80 minutes to Kurumayama-kata. Enjoy mountain hut gourmet for lunch, then soak your body at the Roman style tattoo friendly hot spa.

♣Hot Spa: Adult (12+) Y540, Child (10-11) Y280

>>>Mt. Kurumayama: 1,924m/6312ft, approximately 11km/6.83mi, 4hour, Max elevation 278m/912ft.

Narusawa Ice Cave and Iyashi no Sato Sunday, 21 August 2022 Depart: 0730/ Return: 1600



Our first destination is Narusawa Ice cave, which was formed by the eruption of Mt. Fuji and has an average temperature of 37.4°F throughout the year. Next, we will go to Iyashi no Sato, a Japanese traditional Village. The village is like an open-air museum. It displays several thatched-roofed houses where people can witness, experience, and purchase different local handcrafts as well as learn about traditional Japanese culture.

***In Ice Cave, the path is narrow and very slippery and there's a steep staircase at the exit.**

***Strollers are not allowed to bring in to the cave.**

Wear: Comfortable shoes to walk around.

Bring: Rain gear, Yen for lunch and anything you may need.
