Stroll Rendaiji Onsen and 1000 Hot Spa Sunday, 31 March 2024 Depart: 0600/Return: 2000

We will take you Rendaiji Onsen, a small hot spring town in Shimoda City. First, we will take a 4-minute gondola ride to Nesugatayama Nature Park, which is covered by beautiful seasonal flowers. The observatory used to be a look out point for the famous black ships arriving from the United States. Here you will be able to see a magnificent view of Pacific Ocean. After the Nature Park, we will have an early lunch around Shimoda station, then walk about 45 minutes to Rendaiji Onsen area. We will stop by a privately-owned backyard where you can see 300 weeping peach trees and the bloom of canola flowers. A few minutes from the garden is the historical spot where SHOIN YOSHIDA, in the year 1854, took refuge before his attempt to steal a passage on a black ship. Look at the tricky but unique architecture of the building. Afterwards, soak in the hot spa of Kanaya Ryo-kan. They have "female only" hot spa and unisex hot spa. Their unisex hot spa is the largest Hinoki (Japanese cypress) bathtub in Japan and it's called "Senin-buro" (bath for 1000 people). It is 20m/66ft long, 5m/16ft wide and the deepest part of the tub is 1m/3ft! Females are allowed to cover with bath towels to soak at the unisex hot spa. Enjoy the huge bathtub and the beautiful Japanese wooden architecture.

***There is no soap/shampoo available at the hot spa. Please bring on your own if you need.**

Nanbo, Chikura Hiking

Sunday, 03 March 2024
Depart: 0500/Return: 1630



Hiking starts near Chikura port, where you can see strangely shaped stones above the surface of the ocean. Walk along the coastline about 2km, then walk towards the small peak of Mt. Takatsuka. Climb about 20 minutes in the broadleaf grove to the top of the mountain. From the summit, you will be able to see the Pacific Ocean and our goal, the Breeze Kingdom. Descend the mountain and have fun hiking in a field of flowers. Many flowers (poppies, pot marigolds, snapdragons, stocks, rape flowers and more) produce a spring atmosphere. Going back to the coastline, cross the 150m long Chikura Bridge and our goal is only 15 minutes ahead. The Breeze Kingdom is a roadside station, which includes restaurants, shops, a huge park, tide pool and a fishing ship display. You might have a chance to taste organic edible flowers there, and flower picking will be available across the street.

♣Flower picking: Y30~ per flower.

***It is for ages 6 and up.**

***Flowers are weather dependent. We cannot guarantee that they are in bloom.**

Wear: Hiking shoes, Comfortable clothing to walk, Cap/hat with strap.

Himenosawa Park Obstacle Course

Saturday, 09 March 2024
Depart: 0730/Return: 1630



Our adventure begins with a cable car ride through Jukkoku Pass, a place where you could look over 10 counties (Jukkoku) in ancient times. Walk 10 minutes from the cable car summit station is the entrance to Himenosawa Park. Warm-up and challenge yourself on a 3.5km 40 obstacles set on a steep mountain slope (will take 3 hours to complete the course!) In the afternoon, we will head to Atami City for lunch and free time.

***It is for all ages, however you cannot use stroller at the park.**

***You cannot play on the obstacle course if you consume alcohol.**

***Ages 9 and under must stay around the obstacle course with a parent/legal guardian.**

Wear: Sneakers, Long pants, (Gloves), Cap/hat

Bring: Towel, Water, Yen for lunch and anything you may need.

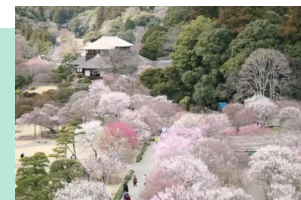

Mito Kairakuen & Ushiku Buddha

Let's enjoy watching and walking through plum blossoms at Mito Kairakuen. It's located in Ibaraki prefecture and was built relatively recently in 1841 by the local lord Tokugawa Nariyuki. Ranked among Japan's finest landscape gardens, Kairakuen is most famous for its over 3,000 plum trees. After that, we will take you to Tomobe SA for lunch then Ushiku Buddha. It's 328 feet (100 meters) tall and you will be overwhelmed once you get to close to it.

Wear: Comfortable shoes and clothing to walk around.

Bring: Rain gear, Yen for lunch and anything you may need.

Kozaki Town Sake Festival

Sunday, 17 March 2024

Kozaki town is known as the brewery town. During the Edo period, the town used the adjacent Tone River as a water source for brewery. At its height, there were seven sake breweries and there are only two that exists today. Since 2009, the town started hosting its annual brewery festival in March and 50,000 people visited at the smallest town in Chiba prefecture. About 200 venders opened booths to sell foods, vegetables, local products, crafts etc. before COVID-19 spread, and it will be first time to be held since 2019! Highlight of the festival will be Sake tasting. You can try variety of Sake for a free and/or a fee. Brewery tour will also be available on the festival day. Music performance will be held at the stage as well.

***It is for all ages; however we do not recommend small children/strollers due to crowd.**

Wear: Comfortable shoes to walk around.

Bring: Rain gear, Shopping bag/Shopping cart trolley, Yen for lunch, shopping and anything you may need.

Dragon peaks Hiking

Sunday, 24 March 2024
Depart: 0600/Return: 1500

Let's celebrate dragon year and climb male and female dragon peaks with us. First, we will climb 5 minutes to the peak of female dragon. Then we will walk on 15 minutes to the dam on Lake Shiroyama. Gaze the water surface shining with spring sunlight, then we will walk into woods area. Keep going up for 70 minutes, we will get to the junction for Mt. Engubo. From the junction to the male dragon peak will be a 30-minute descent. From the observatory point on the peak, you will be able to see a remarkable view of the Western Kanto Plain region to include Miura Bay, Tokyo Sky Tree, and Mt. Tsukuba (if clear weather permits). Walk on a paved road for 35 minutes until reaching "Katakuri-no-sato" (cluster of dogtooth violet), which is the end of this hiking course. The private property is only open to the public this time of year. Here you will be able to see 300,000 dogtooth violets, 100 kinds of trees (such as peach and cherry blossom trees), azaleas, and other beautiful plants.

***For ages 6 and up.**

***Bring picnic blanket/basket and packed lunch.**

***The flower hill might be closed due to the owner's circumstances.**

The tour will not be cancelled despite the closure of the flower hill.

Wear: Trekking shoes, appropriate clothing for hiking, cap/hat.

Bring: Rain gear, sunscreen, sunglasses, towel, water/snacks/lunch, picnic blanket, yen for anything you may need.

Cost: Adult (12+) \$37, Youth (6-11) \$33
