## Requirements for Boarding at Camp Zama Pet Kennels

Puppies (dogs under 1 year of age):
<ul> <li>[ ] At least two (2) Distemper Combo vaccines given 4-6 weeks apart from the time the puppy is 8 weeks old. (This is known as the "puppy series")</li> <li>[ ] Rabies given at least 12 weeks of age</li> <li>[ ] Bordetella give at least 12 weeks of age</li> </ul>
Kittens (cats under 1 year of age):  [ ] Negative FelV/FIV test  [ ] At least two (2) Felocell Combo vaccines given 4-6 weeks apart from the time the kitten is 8 weeks old. (This is known as the "kitten series")  [ ] Rabies
*As a note we cannot board puppies or kittens under 6 months of age due to vaccine coverage requirements.
Dogs (dogs over 1.5 years old): [ ] Rabies (yearly) [ ] Bordetella (yearly) [ ] Distemper Combo vaccine (given every 3 years after the pet's first booster at 1.5 years of age)
Cats (cats over 1.5 years old):  [ ] Felv/FIV negative test (yearly)  [ ] Rabies (every 3 years after the booster vaccine at 1.5 years of age)  [ ] Felocell Combo (every 3 years after the booster vaccine at 1.5 years of age)
[ ] Both species are required to have adequate flea/tick/parasite prevention applied at least 72-hours prior to facility entrance. Pets found to have internal/external parasites will require immediate removal from our facility.
- We cannot board females in heat of either species. If discovered we will call you/your contacts to remove your pet.
- There is a 72-hour grace period between ANY vaccine administration and permitted pet boarding. Your animal will be denied entrance into our facility if you attempt to board them within 72 hours after vaccinating. This is to give the pet's body time to adjust to the vaccine without any adverse reactions which could be amplified by stress in a kenneling environment.

- Animals must be in good health, non-aggressive, and well-mannered in order to stay in our facility. Should we find any change in attitude, health, or demeanor in your pet will be expressed to you/your contacts and a decision based on the wellbeing of the animal will be made at that time.
