Shosenkyo Hiking Saturday, 05 November 2022 Depart: 0630/Return: 1530



Let's walk through the most beautiful gorge in Japan, Shosenkyo! Due to its amazing scenery and abundant clarity, Shosenkyo Gorge has been designated as Japan Heritage! Beginning of the hike, you will be able to see unique-shaped rocks along Arakawa River. Walk about 30 minutes and you will get to Tenkorin woods. By stomping firmly on the ground, you might be able to hear echoes emanating from underground, a natural phenomenon. 40 minutes from Tenkorin, you will pass through a naturally-formed stone gate. The highlight of the gorge, the Sengataki Waterfall, is a few minutes from the stone gate. Climb 180 steps and you will arrive at the Crystal Street where we will enjoy lunch and free time. You'll have the opportunity to ride a gondola, visit museums, taste wine and crystal hunting.

>>Shosenkyo Trail: Approximately 5km, 1.5 hour hiking *It is for all ages, however we do not recommend to use strollers. Wear: Comfortable shoes and clothing for hiking, Cap/hat. Bring: Rain gear (Folding umbrella), Extra clothes, Gloves, Sunglasses, Sunscreen, Towel, Water/snacks, Yen for lunch and anything you may need.

Kasama Pottery Fest & Sightseeing Sunday, 06 November 2022 Depart: 0600/Return: 1900



Enjoy your day off at Kasama City, one of the biggest pottery industry in Kanto Plain. In the morning, we will visit Kasama's Autumn Pottery festival. About 80 booths will stand in a row to sale their potteries, hand crafts, local products etc. Kasama City has unique municipal bylaw that drink sake brewed at Kasama with Kasama pottery CHOKO (small sake cup). Get CHOKO at the market, and sake at the shopping street in front of the nest destination, Kasama Inari Shrine. The shrine is established in 651 and the 114th Chrysanthemum Festival will be held this year. There used to be walnut thick forest at the shrine and the rarity INARI-ZUSHI containing the walnuts is sold at in front of Inari Shrine. Kasama is also famous for production of good quality of granite. Our last destination will be the ruin of quarry for the granite. The ruin is nicknamed "the uncharted lake" and getting popular as photogenic spot. See the magnificent scenery just like an archaeological site.

*The pottery festival is subject to cancel depending on COVID-19 condition. Tour will not be cancelled even if the festival is cancelled. If the festival is cancelled, we will take you to the street the pottery shops are in line.

Some of the homes are over 400 years old, making the site a national treasure which holds a special place in the heart of Japan. Takayama area which has been called "Little Kyoto" Its temples, shrines, rivers and bridges are indeed reminiscent of the famed Kyoto on a smaller scale, yet it provides some delights that even Kyoto cannot match!! ***The location is subject to change due to traffic.**

Sumata Gorge Hiking Sunday, 20 November 2022 Depart: 0500/Return: 1800



Sumata gorge is located at the bottom of Southern Japan Alps, famous for its beautiful nature and hot spa. We will hike 60 minutes on a trail in the woods, which is called Green Shower Road. It is connected to the Sumata Gorge promenade course. The highlight of the hike will be Yume-no-Tsuribashi (suspension bridge of the dream.) This suspension bridge is nominated as one of the world's top ten suspension bridges you should walk in your life. Cross the 90m bridge 8m above a mysterious turquoise blue water, then climb steep 304 steps to the view point. After the view point, we will cross Hiryu-bashi (flying dragon bridge) then arrive at our goal, Sumatakyo Onsen Area. We will take lunch break around Senzu station, which is the station you can see a steam locomotive.
