Stroll Take Island & Laguna Illumination

Enjoy last Saturday of the year at Aichi prefecture! Our first destination will be Haccho miso factory. At the factory tour, you will be amazed to see the 350 stones (approximately 3 tons) are piled up on the 6 tons of Miso by manpower. The end factory tour, you have chance to taste miso products. Next, we will head to Take Island, which is designated as a national treasure. Cross 387m bridge to land on the island and stroll for 45 minutes. The highlight of the tour will be the night illumination at Laguna. Making use of outdoor pools, floating illumination objects are set on the water, and the lights reflecting the surface of water make fantastic atmosphere. Rides are also available during the illumination hours, so you can go through the righted up over bridges as riding the electric boat. Do not miss this opportunity to see the one of the most beautiful illuminations in Japan!

They change the concept and layout every year. This year, the theme of the illumination is Disco from the 90's. We will stop by Outlet Mall Kisarazu for Christmas shopping and lunch.

Kahburi Pass Hiking Sunday, 08 December 2024 Depart: 0700/Return: 1600

Our hike starts from Kariyado Shrine, where the simper face guardian dog is enshrined. First, we will walk along the stream, then enter the trail in the cedar woods. The starting point to the Kohburi pass will be about 70 minutes uphill. Beautiful autumn scenery with Chichibu's mountains and Mt. Fuji will be expected from the Kohburi pass! Take a break at the tea house at the Kohburi pass and walk about 60 minutes to the half point of this course, Kasasugi pass. From the Kasasugi pass, gentle uphill continues till our goal, Black Mountain Three Waterfalls. You might be able to see monks meditate under the waterfall. Waterfalls to the parking lot will be a 15-minute walk where the MWR bus is parked. There are a couple of restaurants around the parking lot. Enjoy lunch at the local restaurants.

>>>Highest peak will be 622m/2,041ft, Approximately 4 hour (break time excluded), 9km/5.59mi, Max Elevation 422m/1,384ft.

Mt. Imayama Hiking Saturday, 14 December 2024 Depart: 0800/Return: 20:30



Let's go to the town of the sunset, Western Izu for hiking. We will start hiking from Arari port while watching ships in anchor for 20 minutes, then enter the mountain trail. After a 50-minute ascending, you will get to the view point for Cape Koganezaki (golden) and Cape Koibitomisaki (lover). On this hiking course, you can also enjoy a beautiful view of the cobalt blue ocean, rocky coastline at Taqo area, aloe flowers, and Mt Fuji if the weather is clear. After 4 hours of hiking, we will head to Cape Koganezaki to see Japan's best sunset. You will be able to see cliffs shining in gold, and the sky and the ocean are aglow with the setting sun.

>>>Imayama: 303m/994ft, Approximately 7km/4.4mi, 3.5 hours (break time excluded), Max elevation 302m/991ft.

Setagaya Boroichi Market Sunday, 15 January 2024 Depart: 0730/Return: 1430

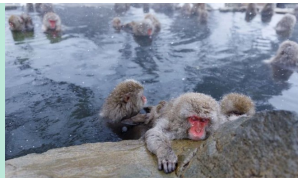

Wild Monkey & Matsumoto Castle Saturday, 21 December 2024 Depart: 0430/ Return: 2000



Visit Jigokudani Wild Monkey Park and enjoy this rare opportunity to observe the interesting lifestyle of Japanese macaque monkeys. Almost 200 monkeys inhabit the area and relax by bathing in the hot spring. Afterwards, we will head to Matsumoto Castle. The castle formerly named "Fukashi" was built over 400 years ago. The six-story black painted wooden keep is the oldest surviving structure in Japan and is a designated national treasure.

***Please bring or wear appropriate shoes for a 40-min one-way walk at the monkey park.**

***No strollers allowed at the monkey park.**

***We do not guarantee you will be able to see bathing monkeys.**

***You have to take off your shoes to enter Matsumoto Castle and there's steep staircase.**

Wear: Comfortable shoes and clothing to walk, cap/hat.

Bring: Warm clothes, Rain gear, Snow gear, Yen for lunch and anything you may need.

Mt. Daruma Trekking Sunday, 22 December 2024 Depart: 0500/Return: 1700



We will go through two peaks to aim for Mt. Daruma on Izu peninsula. Due to its panoramic view, it is nicknamed Jusankoku pass, a peak you can look over 13 counties. First 60 minutes, we will walk on the offroad and paved road alternately, then arrive at Toi parking. 20 minutes uphill from the parking lot will be the first peak, Mt. Garan. Another 20 minutes uphill is following until next peak, Mt. Koki. Keep walking on the trail in the bamboo grass field for 30 minutes, we will get to the summit of Mt. Daruma.

Experience the breath-taking panoramic view at the summit. For the descent, we will go down on the wooden steps for 80 minutes

To our goal, Heda Pass bus stop.

>>>Mt. Daruma: 982m/3,222ft, Approximately 11km/6.84mi, 210min, Max elevation 408m/1,339ft.
