Kasama Chestnut Festival
Saturday, 05 October 2024

Kasama, famous as the pottery town, is also known as the top chestnut producing area in Japan. For celebrating good harvest, they hold chestnut festival every October. Purchase chestnut products, then taste roast chestnuts, chestnut ice cream and freshly squeezed chestnut paste etc. Fun games such as chestnut golf, burr dart, craft workshops are available as well. After the festival, we will visit the most popular temple and shrine in Kasama City.

Mt. Fuji Ochudo Hiking
Sunday, 06 October 2024
Depart: 0500/Return: 1430



Did you miss Mt. Fuji climbing season this year? No worry, still have an option to hike on Mt. Fuji! Join us for the short hike, the Ochudo Trail! Ochudo used to be the holy trail circle around 5-stations, only allowed for people who had climbed Mt. Fuji more than three times. Now it is open for everyone to walk, but only a part of the ancient trail is accessible due to landslides. We will hike from the Subaru line 5 station through Oniwa area to the hidden beautiful spot Okuniwa. Enjoy viewing KOYO (leaves turning red, yellow and orange), bird watching and tasty autumn local foods.

>>>Ochudo Trail: approximately 4km/2.48mi, 1.5 hour hiking, Max elevation 55m/180ft.
***It is for ages 6 and up.**
***Temperature at 5 station in October gets lower than 5C (41F). Please bring winter clothes.**

Wear: Trekking shoes, Appropriate clothing for hiking, Cap/hat.
Bring: Rain suits, Sunscreen, Sunglasses, Towel, Trekking poles, Jacket/Extra clothes, (Change of clothes,) Snacks/Water, Yen for lunch (or bring own packed lunch) and anything you may need.

Yokoya Gorge Hiking
Sunday, 13 October 2024
Depart: 0500/Return: 1630



Yokoya gorge is created by erosion of Shibu river and 6km hiking trails are set along the river. You will be able to see dynamic waterfalls while hiking. To the first waterfall from the parking lot will be 10 minute walk. If it is sunny, you will be able to see a rainbow around the waterfall. Walk about 10 minutes, second waterfall will be seen. Keep walking as watching strange shape rocks for 30 minutes, then ascend steep uphill for 15 minutes, you will arrive at Yokoya Kannon Temple. Take a break, then get back to the trail by the river to see the highlight of the trail, the two stories waterfall. Pass the last waterfall and cross the Shibu River, and go toward our goal, the mysterious pond, Mishaka.

Kashima-Jingu Shrine & Farmer's Village

Our first destination is Kashima-Jingu Shrine. It is a traditional and prestigious shrine located in Kashima City, the south-eastern part of Ibaraki Prefecture and it is the oldest Shinto shrine in the Kanto region. Enjoy strolling the shrine and refresh your mind. The torii gate was collapsed by 3.11 earthquake but now it is reconstructed. Our next destination is Namegata Farmer's Village. If you like sweet potatoes, this is the best place to go! It is a sweet potato and agriculture experience-based theme park. You can eat, play, learn and shop as well!

Kawagoe Festival

Re-creating the splendor and allure of the Edo period, this festival in Saitama prefecture features magnificent 20-30ft tall floats with costumed dancers representing various local cities. They break out into drum battles at each street corner, and the winner of the battle gets the lead the parade.

Additionally, there is a mikoshi (portable shrine) procession. We will stop at SA for lunch first.

Daigahara Post Town Craft/Antique Market

Daigahara developed as the post town on Koshu Kaido (current route 20) in Edo era. 50,000 people visit Daigahara on the 3rd weekend of October every year. Their target will be the craft/antique market. More than 200 booths are set along with 750m street. Cray, glass, wood, leather, metal, rice paper, fabric etc., crafts made from many kind of material are sold at open air. You will find the "one-of-a-kind"!
***Please bring enough cash. ATM will not be available around the market area.**

Stroll Photogenic spots at Niigata
