

The grounds are dotted with facilities that talk of its history and cover a total area of roughly 2,741 acres. The Tokyo National Museum is one of the most important structures in the park. On display are many important national treasures and cultural properties of Japan. There is also the National Science Museum in the park.

You will be able to see the historical remains of Old Tokaido while walking.
