Hike on The Divine Kasamori Trail Sunday, 24 February 2019 Depart: 0700/Return: 1630



"Ray Line" is the orbit of the Sun on the Vernal and Autumnal Equinox Day (north latitude 35 degree), and considered as the holy degree in Japan. 13 power spots such as Mt. Fuji and Izumo Shrine are scattered and our hike starts from the second spot on the Ray Line, Kasamori Temple. The approach to the temple site will be 130 steep stone steps surrounded by cedar trees. Climb about 20 minutes and you will see the 1000 year-old wooden main hall. The main hall is the singular building constructed with the Shihokake-zukuri architectural style, and it is designated as one of Japan's important cultural property. The hiking trail continues from behind the main hall to Nomigane Park. Keep walking on the wooden steps about 120 minutes going up and down until our goal, Nomigane Park. On a clear day, the view of Tokyo Skytree is expected and Kawazu cherry blossom will be in bloom at the park.



Mt. Shidango is the one of the easiest mountains to climb in Tanzawa area and well known for its amazing scenic view from the summit. First, we will walk about 30 minutes on a paved road until the gate for the hiking trail. The gate to the top of Mt. Shidango will be a 105-minute climb through two peaks. Clear the steep climb right before the top of Shidango for the beautiful panoramic view! Bring hot chocolate/coffee in a thermos bottle to take a breath while enjoying Tanzawa Mountains and Sagami Bay scenery. We will descend about 65 minutes to the parking lot where the MWR bus will be. 10 minutes from the parking lot will be the largest wax plum garden in Kanto plain. Enjoy lunch and plum flower festival at the garden.

Kamikochi is one of the most famous scenic spots in Japan and two million tourist visit every year. In November the area is blocked until the beginning of mountaineering season and covered with snow. Let's walk around the white silent Kamikochi with snowshoes and find out how beautiful it is! Beginning will be the hardest part of this tour, 60-minute paved road walking in Kama Tunnel without snowshoes. Uphill continues about 2.5km, then we will arrive at Taisho Pond, the entrance of Kamikochi. Put on the snowshoes and walk about 90 minutes on the snow to Kappabashi Bridge. You will be able to see snow covered Mt. Yake with volcanic smoke, dynamic Hotaka Mountain Range, hoarfrost at Tashiro Pond, and Kappabashi Bridge free of tourists. Have quick lunch then walk back toward Kama Tunnel. Do not miss this rare opportunity to see K amikochi's winter beauty.

>>>Approximately 6 hour, 12km (7.45mi.) course.
