

Kamikochi is one of the most famous scenic spots in Japan and two million tourists visit every year. In November, the area is blocked until the end of April and covered with snow. Let's walk around the white silent Kamikochi with snowshoes and find out how beautiful it is! Beginning will be the hardest part of this tour, 60-minute paved road walking in Kama Tunnel without snowshoes. Uphill continues about 2.5km, then we will arrive at Taisho Pond, the entrance of Kamikochi. Put on the snowshoes and walk about 90 minutes on the snow toward Kappabashi Bridge. You will be able to see snow covered Mt. Yake with volcanic smoke, dynamic Hotaka Mountain Range, hoarfrost at Tashiro Pond, and Kappabashi Bridge free of tourists. Do not miss this rare opportunity to see Kamikochi's winter beauty.
