



One of the "must-go" destinations for hikers, Oze is known as the paradise of beautiful flowers. An area of 8,690ha (106 times wider than Tokyo Disneyland!), which is designated as a National Park and registered as a Ramsar site, is covered with more than 300 different kinds of plants during the hiking season. This massive area stretches over three prefectures (Gunma, Nigata, Fukushima) and its scenic beauty which includes marshes, ponds, ravines, forests and mountains delight visitors. We are going to enter Oze through Hatomachi Pass, which is the closest entrance from Tokyo, and enjoy 2 days of hiking. Approximately 3 hours of hiking on the 1st day, stay and relax at the mountain hut, then 6 hours of fun hiking on the 2nd day! This time of year, is peak season for the "KUSA-MOMIJI (grass changing color to red, yellow and orange in the fall), and Oze is a rare place where you can witness KUSA-MOMIJI. At the end of fall, Oze starts to cover up with snow and closes until the following spring. To conserve nature, you cannot use shampoo, rinse/conditioner, soap/face wash, toothpaste/mouthwash and detergent in the Oze area.

\*Accommodation is a mountain hut, NOT COMFORTABLE HOTEL. Room may be shared by all the hikers regardless of gender.
