Have you given up on reaching the top of Mt. Fuji? Are you uncertain that you can hike for 10 hours? Why don't you try taking 2 days to climb Fuji slowly with a small group? First day, we will ascend on the Yoshida trail from the Subaru line 5<sup>th</sup> sta. to the 8<sup>th</sup> sta. We will have supper and rest at the mountain hut. On the second day, wake up early to see the sunrise from the summit. Our climbing guide will support you to get to the highest point in Japan!

*\*The success of reaching the summit contains many factors such as weather conditions and participants' physical fitness. We do not guarantee that everyone can get to the top. Please attend the overnight Fuji briefing on Tuesday, 13 August at 1800 (at ODR). If you cannot take it on the 13<sup>th</sup>, please attend one of the briefings for one-day Fuji climbing.*

**\*Accommodation is a mountain hut, NOT A COMFORTABLE HOTEL. Room may be shared by all the climbers regardless of gender.**

**Friday, 05 July 2019 @ Zama ODR (1700-1800)**



**Stroll Koajiro-no-mori**  
**Saturday, 06 July 2019**  
**Depart: 0530/Return: 1300**

Koajiro-no-mori is the forest which faces Koajiro Bay. This is the rare place that you can see the forest, cliff, marsh, morass, tideland and ocean in the 70ha (0.27 sq mi) area. These varieties of nature gathered along the 1.2km (0.74mi) stream, are conserved without any artificial objects and with more than 2,000 species. It was opened to the public in 2014 and a walking path is set throughout the area. We will enter from the forest side and see the environments change to the ocean. At the tideland, you might be able to see small crabs' dance called waving! After enjoying precious nature, we will head to vegetable café to have healthy lunch.

**Tokyo Summerland**  
**Saturday, 06 July 2019**

Tokyo Summerland is a huge indoor/outdoor water park in Tokyo. It's fun for all ages and a great place to cool down. The park has large pools, waterslides, a man-made beach and pools for small children. The large indoor park is kept at 30 degrees Celsius so visitors can enjoy it all year round.

Take the day off with family and friends to enjoy clam digging at the warm Futtsu beach in Chiba Prefecture. Digging fee includes Adult 2kg, Youth 1kg, Child 1kg of clams.

**Bring:** Gloves, hat, beach sandals or shoes, change of clothes, towels, Yen for food/drinks (We recommend you bring your own food/drinks)

**>>>Conquer Mt. Fuji! Initial**  
**Mt.Fuji Hiking 1<sup>st</sup>~5<sup>th</sup> station**  
**Saturday, 13 July 2019**  
**Depart: 0600/Return: 2000**



Let's walk from the bottom of Mt. Fuji before you aim for the summit. First, we will stop by Fuji Sengen Shrine to get the climbing sticks (Kongo-zue), then move to Umagaeshi where our hike starts. Umagaeshi to the 3<sup>rd</sup> station will be a 90 minute hike on a comfortable trail in the woods. After the 3<sup>rd</sup> station, the trail gets steeper and steeper, climbing for another 45 minutes until we reach the 4.5<sup>th</sup> station at an altitude of 2,010m. Climb 50 minutes to the Yoshida 5<sup>th</sup> station and then detour for 35 minutes to the hidden 6<sup>th</sup> station to get rare stamps. Then we will descend 40 minutes toward our goal, Subaru line 5<sup>th</sup> station. It will be perfect training to get used to the high altitude.

Climbing stick: Y800~Y2,000 Stamps: Y300~Y500

Enjoy a day outdoors to experience picking fresh summer vegetables on a farm in Chiba Prefecture. You can pick and take corn, edamame beans, tomatoes, and cucumbers home. You can also taste watermelon on the spot. You will next head to Mother Farm. You'll have an opportunity to interact with the cows, horses, goats, alpacas and other animals, as well as see animal shows and petting zoo and also enjoy a variety of seasonal flowers.

Tenjozan is located at the south east side of Lake Kawaguchi and famous for the story, Kachikachiyama. Approximately 4.1km (2.55mi) trails are surrounded with 100,000 hydrangea this time of the year and fascinate all the hikers. Once you get to the top, you can see Lake Kawaguchi underneath and majestic Mt. Fuji is in front of you!

Afterwards, Matsumoto Castle, one of Japan's national treasures. The castle is unique in design and its donjon (central fortress) is the oldest and largest known in Japan.
