


Asakusa's main attraction is its famous Sensoji Buddhist temple that was built in the 7<sup>th</sup> century. Surrounding the temple are many shopping streets that offer a variety of souvenirs, as well as traditional and local food. In addition to Sensoji temple is the famous Kaminarimon (Kaminari Gate). Tokyo Tower is a communications and observation tower in Minato district. Standing at 332.9m (1092ft.) tall, it is the second largest structure in Japan. Meiji Shrine was competed and dedicated to the Emperor Meiji and Empress Shoken in 1920. Meiji Shine is one of Japan's most popular shrines. In the first days of the New Year, the shrine regularly welcomes more than three million visitors for the year's first prayers (hatsumode), more than any other shrine or temple in the country. During the rest of the year, traditional Shinto weddings can often be seen taking place there.

Setagaya. Today, an estimated 700 dealers participate in the "Boro Ichi". Come out to enjoy a day of bargain hunting. The food stalls are just as legendary as the market itself.

# **Mishima Skywalk**, & Numazu Port

Visit Japan's longest pedestrian suspension bridge. Located in Shizuoka Prefecture, Mishima Sky Walk is 400m (1312ft.) long and 70m (230ft.) high. The facility offers outstanding views of Mt. Fuji and Suruga Bay from the observation deck and a beautiful indoor "Sky Garden" where you can enjoy the fully bloomed colorful hanging flowers as well as a café and souvenir shops. After the Mishima Skywalk, you will enjoy picking sweet & juicy strawberries. You can eat as many strawberries as you wish during the 30 minute period. Once you've had your fill of strawberries, we will head down to Numazu port where there's a vibrant fish market, many seafood restaurants for lunch and local souvenirs to purchase.
