

# Chofu Shichifukujin (Seven Gods) Visiting Walk Saturday, 04 January 2020 **Depart: 0745/Return: 1730**



Visiting Shichifukujin, the seven gods of good luck, is a traditional event to celebrate New Year. We will stroll through Chofu City to greet all the gods to pray for good fortune. Collecting holy stamps at each temple is customary when visiting the seven gods and Chofu is a rare place where you can collect god-shaped clay bells at each temple. First, we will visit three temples by bus, then visit the rest of the temples on foot. Our goal will be the Shindaiji Temple, which the god of battle, Bishamonten, is enshrined. This temple is wellknown to bring you good relationship. There are many Soba noodle restaurants around the temple. Take the time to enjoy their local cuisine.
