# Kozaki Town Walking Sunday, 25 April 2021 Depart: 0600 / Return: 1630





Kozaki is known as the brewery town. During the Edo period, the town used the adjacent Toner River as a water source for brewery. At its height, there were seven sake breweries. There are only two that exists today. Since 2009, this small town in Chiba has been hosting its annual brewery festival in March and is visited by about 50,000 people (8 times of the population of the town). Stroll through Kozaki and visit historical and natural sites and see the magnificent Tone River!. At the end of walk, you will have chance to purchase sake from the area and other fermented food gathered from all over Japan!





Kiryu is a historical town in Gunma Prefecture, established by silk fabric industries during the Nara era. The fabric industry had declined in the middle of the Showa period, but the nostalgic townscape of the former days still remain. There are many uniquely shaped buildings, remnants of fabric factories. They have been renovated as event halls, cafés, bakeries. museums etc. Stroll through Kirvu town and explore the photogenic spots and other points of interests! Mt. Zukko is a small peak in Hadano that's famous for its double-flowered cherry blossom. Their cherry blossom pickle production accounts about 80 percent of its domestic production. Let's visit the area to see the harvesting of flowers, a special feature in spring! First, we will walk on payed road for 35 minutes to a flower temple. Senzoii. The entrance to Mt. Zukko will be 15 minutes from the temple. When trail changes to off road, we will ascend for about 20 minutes and arrive at the top of Mt. Zukko. Have tea break while gazing at the double-flowered cherry blossom!

# **Fujieda Morning Hike** Saturday, 24 April 2021 **Depart: 0300 / Return: 1300**



Fujieda, located in Shizuoka Prefecture, is famous for its high quality green tea production. Due to the nature of the tea industry, the workday begins early in the morning so let's take an early morning hike to enjoy a delicious breakfast! Beginning of the hike to Kivomizu Temple, via the Fujieda Sports Park, will be about 30 minutes on paved road. Trek through shrines and ascend for about 20 minutes before seeing a huge water tank. 70 minutes from the water tank is a bamboo yard, a tea plantation and ancient burial mounds. We will arrive at Rengedera Pond Park to stroll around the pond that has wisteria. Enjoy a Fujieda style breakfast called "Asarah". >>>Mt. Kiyomizu: 232m/761ft, Approximately 6.5km/4mi, 2.5hour, Max elevation 202m/662ft.
