

Requirements for services at Camp Zama Pet Care Center

Puppies (dogs under 1 year of age):

- At least two (2) Da2PPCV Combo vaccines given 4-6 weeks apart from the time the puppy is 8 weeks old. (This is known as the "puppy series")
- Rabies given at least 12 weeks of age
- Bordetella give at least 12 weeks of age

Kittens (cats under 1 year of age):

- Negative FeIV/FIV test
- At least two (2) Felocell Combo vaccines given 4-6 weeks apart from the time the kitten is 8 weeks old. (This is known as the "kitten series")
- Rabies

*As a note we cannot board puppies or kittens under 6 months of age due to vaccine coverage requirements.

Dogs (dogs over 1.5 years old):

- Rabies (yearly)
- Bordetella (yearly)
- Distemper Combo vaccine (given every 3 years after the pet's first booster at 1.5 years of age)

Cats (cats over 1.5 years old):

- Felv/FIV negative test (yearly)
- Rabies (every 3 years after the booster vaccine at 1.5 years of age)
- Felocell Combo (every 3 years after the booster vaccine at 1.5 years of age)

Both species are required to have adequate flea/tick/parasite prevention applied at least 72-hours prior to facility entrance. Pets found to have internal/external parasites will require immediate removal from our facility.

- We cannot board/groom females in heat. If discovered we will call you/your contacts to remove your pet.

- There is a 72-hour grace period between ANY vaccine administration and permitted pet boarding. Your animal will be denied services for our facility if the grace period is not honored. This is to give the pet's body time to adjust to the vaccine without any adverse reactions which could be amplified by stress in a kenneling environment.

- Animals must be in good health, non-aggressive, and well-mannered in order to receive services in our facility. Should we find any change in attitude, health, or demeanor in your pet will be expressed to you/your contacts upon discovery.
