One of the "must-go" destinations for hikers, Oze is known as the paradise of beautiful flowers. An area of 8,690ha (106 times wider than Tokyo Disneyland!), is covered with more than 300 different kinds of plants during the hiking season. This massive area stretches over three prefectures and its scenic beauty which includes marshes, ponds, ravines, forests, and mountains delights visitors. We are going to enjoy 2 days of hiking. Approximately 3 hours of hiking on the 1st day, stay and relax at the mountain hut, then 6 hours of fun hiking on the 2nd day! During this time of the year, marshes are covered with daylilies and they form the marsh into a yellow carpet. This is the best season to see various flowers at Oze.

*To conserve the nature of Oze, you cannot use shampoo, rinse/ conditioner, soap, toothpaste/mouthwash and detergent in the Oze



Nezame-no-toko located in Nagano prefecture, it literally means "wake-up bed". It is a bed of rocks at an enchanting location along the Kiso river, known for its fascinating rock formations and its beautiful emerald green color water. Our net stop is Magomejuku. Where during Edo period there were five roadways that connected to Edo (Tokyo) and outlying regions. The Nakasendo road linked Edo and Kyoto which ran through central Japan. It has 69 posting stations of which Magome-juku was the 43rd. Walking through Magome-juku will transport you back to Edo period. Enjoy the local food and get some souvenirs as well!

Stroll Hakone Sunday, 12 May 2024 Depart: 0700/Return: 1700



Izu-Hakone National Park is one of the most famous tourist resorts in Japan and is known to be an area of strong spiritual power. Visiting Hakone Shrine, Kuzuryu Hongu Shrine and Hakone Mototsumiya is called SANSYA MAIRI (visiting three shrines) and it is believed that you will receive the full divine protection of the gods. We will walk for 30 minutes from Kojiri area to Kuzuryu shrine where walking and/or taking boat ride are the only way to get to. Walk another 30 minutes to the door to the Mototsumiya shrine, Komagatake Ropeway station. The shrine is located at the top of Mt. Komagatake and you will be able to enjoy the magnificent view from the summit. Our next stop will be Yama-no-Hotel where we will visit a flower garden and see the view of Ashi Lake, Mt. Fuji with white snow cap, and colorful azalea flowers. Next to the hotel is Hakone shrine which was established in 757. Do not forget to shoot Torii gate standing in the lake.

Kamikochi Hiking Saturday, 18 May 2024 Depart: 0300/Return: 1900



Surrounded by the Japan Alps, Kamikochi is considered one of the most beautiful scenic areas in Japan. We are going to take you to a place that is difficult to visit on your own due to the conservation laws (POV restrictions). Our hike starts at Taishoike Pond that was created by the eruption of Mt. Yakedake. We will slowly walk on a promenade along Azusa River, enjoying the natural scenery of Taishoike Pond and its magnificent alpine plants; Kappabashi Bridge, a symbol of Kamikochi; and the mysterious pond of Myojinike.

*It is for all ages, however we do not recommend small children due to the long bus ride and strollers cannot be used on the hiking trails. *Weather and temperature at the mountains are unpredictable. Please bring extra jacket and rain gear.

*Do not stray from the designated hiking trails. Do not go into the alpine areas and other restricted areas.

Wear: Hiking shoes, appropriate clothing for hiking, cap/hat. **Bring:** Extra clothes, rain gear, hiking shoes, sunscreen, sunglasses, towel, plastic bags for trash, water/snacks, coins (donation for toilet use), Yen for lunch or bring packed lunch and anything you may need. **Cost:** Adult/Youth/Child \$52 **(Guide, Transportation included)**





We will go through two peaks to aim for Mt. Daruma on Izu peninsula. Due to its panoramic view, it is nicknamed Jusankoku pass, a peak you can look over 13 counties (Jusankoku). First 60 minutes, we will walk on the offroad and paved road alternately, then arrive at Toi parking. 20 minutes uphill from the parking lot will be the first peak, Mt. Garan. Another 20 minutes uphill is following until next peak, Mt. Koki. Keep walking on the trail in the bamboo grass field for 30 minutes, we will get to the summit of Mt. Daruma. Experience the breath-taking panoramic view at the summit. For the descent, we will go down on the wooden steps for 80 minutes toward Heta Pass bus stop. Then we will walk on the paved road for 30 minutes to our goal, Darumayama Kogen Rest house.

>>>Mt. Daruma: 982m/3,222ft, Approximately 11km/6.84mi, 240min, Max elevation 408m/1,339ft.
