**Mt. Tsukuba Hiking
& Plum Blossom Festival**
Sunday, 01 March 2026
Depart: 0500/Return: 1800



Let's climb Mt. Tsukuba to aim for the majestic view of Kasumigaura, Pacific Ocean and mountains which surround Kanto plain. Mt. Tsukuba has two peaks which are called Nantaisan and Nyotaisan, and famous as the holly mountain. We will start climbing from Tsutsujigaoka, ascend 40 minutes until Benkeijaya junction, then keep climbing for 35minutes, arrive at the highest peak, Nantaisan. 15 minutes from Nantaisan will be Miyukigahara where the cable car station is located. Go through the summit of Nantaisan, then walk clockwise around the summit for 60 minutes, then we will be back to Miyukigahara. We will take 8 minutes cable car ride to descend the mountain. The plum yard is located 15 minutes from the cable car bottom station. Enjoy plum blossom festival and taste delicious food and locally brewed plum wine. >>>Mt. Tsukuba: 877m, Approximately 3.85km, 155 minutes hiking.

Stroll Sawara & Spring Festival
Saturday, 07 March 2026
Depart: 0600/Return:1830

Sawara is the waterfront scenic area located in northern Chiba Prefecture. First, we will visit Katori Shrine, which is the head shrine of 400 Katori Shrines in Japan and considered as one of the most powerful shrine in Kanto area. Then we will head to central Sawara, where it was developed as the relay point of Tone River shipping in Edo period. Merchant houses/warehouses constructed at that time are remaining along the canals, and the old wooden constructions are still used as Shoyu/Sake/Oil breweries, drapers, cafes, restaurants etc. This time of year, valuable antic hina dolls are displayed at the shops and hina doll costume cruise on the canal will be seen. Enjoy the beautiful townscape and the Spring festival.

****The hina doll costume cruise is subject to cancel due to rain. The tour will not be cancelled even if the event is cancelled.***

**Mito Kairakuen
& Ushiku Buddha**

Let's enjoy watching and walking through plum blossoms at Mito Kairakuen. It's located in Ibaraki prefecture and was built relatively recently in 1841 by the local lord Tokugawa Nariyuki. Ranked among Japan's finest landscape gardens, Kairakuen is most famous for its over 3,000 plum trees. After that, we will take you to Tomobe SA for lunch then Ushiku Buddha. It's 328 feet (100 meters) tall and you will be overwhelmed once you get to close to it.

Kozaki Town Sake Festival
Sunday, 15 March 2026

Kozaki town is known as the brewery town. During the Edo period, the town used the adjacent Tone River as a water source for brewery. At its height, there were seven sake breweries and there are only two that exist today. Since 2009, the town started hosting its annual brewery festival in March and 50,000 people visited the smallest town in Chiba prefecture. About 200 vendors opened booths to sell food, vegetables, local products, crafts etc. Highlight of the festival will be Sake tasting. You can try variety of Sake for free and/or a fee. Brewery tours will also be available on the festival day. Music performance will be held on the stage as well.

****It is for all ages; however we do not recommend small children due to crowds.***

Hakone Sightseeing
Saturday, 21 March 2026
Depart: 0700/Return: 1800

Let's visit Hakone's famous sightseeing spots! First, we will visit Owakudani, the epicenter of volcanic in Hakone. It is famous for "black egg" which is said to prolong one's life for seven years! After some free time, we will take a ropeway to Togendai, then we will ride a Pirates ship.

Please enjoy extraordinary scenery surrounding Hakone! Don't forget to take pictures of Shrine from the ship. For lunch, we will have some free time around the Old Hakone Check-Point, originally established in 1681 by the Tokugawa Shogunate for the defense of Edo (Tokyo) and to control / regulate travel. Our last destination is Hakone Shrine. It was erected in approximately 757 A.D, that had been designated as an Important Cultural Property.

You must try it, and feel the difference between rice cooked with the electric rice boiler. We will visit a Sake brewery, and a shopping facility which includes seafood BBQ restaurant, bakery, craft beer brewery and souvenir shop as well.
