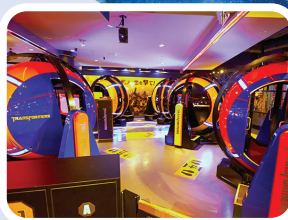
Yamato City Yutori-no-Mori

A high-tech indoor amusement park filled with cutting-edge games, virtual thrills, and futuristic fun.



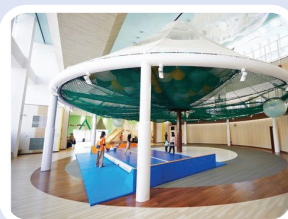
KidZania

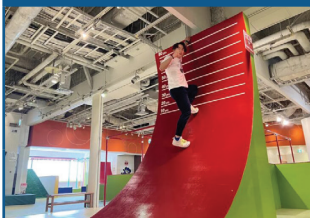
