Enjoy the panoramic view at the summit, then climb down the mountain for 60 minutes. After the mountain walk, we will head to the cluster of narcissus. Walk the path between narcissus for an hour.

>>>Mt. Tomi: 349m/1,145ft, Approximately 8km/4.97mi, 4-hour, Max elevation 285m/935ft.

Ise Shrine is the generic name of Kotaijingu (Naigu) which the top god of Shinto, Amaterasu Omikami (Gegu) is enshrined and Toyoukedaijingu which the god preparing meal for Amaterasu Omikami is enshrined. Amaterasu Omikami is considered as the ancestor of imperial families and only allowed to visit there by the official order from the emperor in ancient times. After Kamakura period (1185-1333), it opened to the public and "Oisemairi", visiting Ise Shrine became one of the big life events for the people of those days. Before visiting Ise shrine, we will stop by Futamiura Beach where the ancient worship visitors purify their body prior going to Ise Shrine. We will visit Gegu, then Naigu. There is a shopping/restaurant district in front of Naigu. Enjoy lunch, souvenir hunting and historical scenery.

***It is for all ages; however, we do not recommend small children due to long bus ride.**

***The shrine site is huge, so please wear comfortable shoes to walk.**

Snow Monkey & Matsumoto Castle

Saturday, 14 February 2026

Visit Jigokudani Wild Monkey Park and enjoy this rare opportunity to observe the interesting lifestyle of Japanese macaque monkeys. Almost 200 monkeys inhabit the area and relax by bathing in the hot spring. Afterwards, we will head to Matsumoto Castle. The castle formerly named "Fukashi" was built over 400 years ago. The six-story black painted wooden keep is the oldest surviving structure in Japan and is a designated national treasure.

***Please bring or wear appropriate shoes/snow boots for a 40-minute one-way walk on the snow to the monkey park.**

***Strollers cannot be used at the monkey park and inside of the castle.**

***We do not guarantee that you can see bathing monkeys.**

Let's hike on powder snow through the larch woods to the mysterious cave, Oyu. At Oyu cave, you will be able to see the unique icicles called "Hyojun (bamboo ice)", which grows from ground up. Last parts to the cave will be steep up hill, but it is worth to challenge to the icicles. While walking on the snow, you will have the chance to see the surrounding beautiful nature and its wild animals, or their footprints left behind. An experienced guide will show you around to have fun and spend a rewarding day!

***For ages 10 and up.**

***The course may be changed without notice depending on the weather/activity area conditions.**

***Sizes for snowshoes are limited. If they do not have your size, you must prepare your own. Ask ODR staff if your shoe size is bigger than 12.**

***Bring own packed lunch. Foods containing water such as rice balls and fruits are possibly frozen. If you are planning to bring jet boil, please prepare the gas cartridge for winter.**

Wear: Snow boots/Snowboard boots/Waterproof boots), Ski wear, Non-cotton material underwear, Knit cap, Ski goggles, Gloves.

Bring: Sunscreen, change of clothes, Towel, Hot drinks in thermos bottle, Lunch/Snacks, Yen for anything you may need.

This tradition is to celebrate prosperous health and growth for girls. Many good luck charms such as owls, chili peppers, and Chinese lantern, made from Chirimen fabric, are hung from the ceiling. Find out the meaning of charms and then head to Kawazu cherry blossom festival. 850 Kawazu cherry trees are planted along Kawazu River and contrast of pink cherry blossom and yellow canola flowers fascinate visitors.
