The facility showcases authentic sets, original costumes, and intricate props, allowing visitors to examine the craftsmanship and technical artistry required for large-scale filmmaking



#### Mr. Jump

A premier indoor trampoline park offering a high energy, all-weather athletic experience for all ages. It features Olymp i-spec trampolines, wall jumping, a giant tube slide, ziplines, and a “Special Glider” monorail.



#### Joypolis

A multi-story indoor amusement park that uses Sega’s gaming technology to power its attractions. The facility houses a mix of motion-simulators, digital-interactive games, and indoor rollercoasters across three floors.

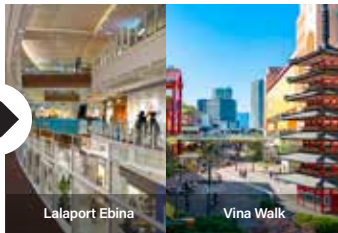
