Obara Honjin Festival is a traditional festival held in Sagami-hara city. It creates the atmosphere of Japan's Edo Period with colorful Daimyo (feudal lord) procession, traditional performances, and historic streets around the preserved Obara Honjin, the only remaining Honjin in Kanagawa. You can wear Japanese kimono and experience Japanese tea ceremony as well.

***Kimono Experience:** Quantities and sizes are limited. Maximum height is up to 180cm/5'11" for men and 170cm/5'7" for women, with a waist size up to 100 cm/39".

Ikenodaira Marshland Hiking
Saturday, 05 September 2026
Depart: 0600/Return: 1700

Ikenodaira Marshland, often described as a "flower garden in the sky," is located at an altitude of 2,000m/6,560ft. Due to its unique climate and extreme temperature swings, you can see alpine plants that typically only grow at over 3,000 m/9,840ft above sea level. In September, larch leaves turn yellow, making the entire marsh shine like gold. First, we will hike along the ridge of the marshland for an hour to the viewpoint, Sanpogamine Peak. From there, you can observe the entire crater-shaped marshland. A 10-minute walk from the peak brings us to Kagami-ike (Mirror Pond). If the wind is calm, the pond beautifully reflects the surrounding mountains. From the pond, we will hike on the wooden boardwalk through the marsh for 40 minutes while admiring the bluish-purple gentian flowers. The region is also famous for its high-quality grape production. Afterward, we will stop by a local winery for a tasting and a Vietnamese lunch.

***Age requirement:** 6 years and older.

Let's spend a day in Nikko! Nikko has many old-style buildings, and it is registered as a UNESCO World Cultural Heritage. Our first stop will be Toshogu Shrine. It is famous for five-story pagoda and its extremely detailed woodcarvings. In addition, you can visit three other sections: Rinnoji Temple, Futarasan Shrine and the Daiyu-in. All three are located inside the shrine's complex. We will also visit Chuzenji Lake, Kegon Waterfall and Ryuzu Waterfall.

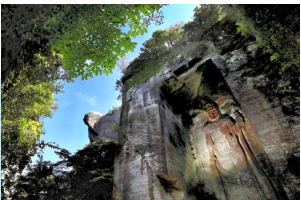

Mt. Nokogiri Hiking
Saturday, 12 September 2026
Depart: 0600 /Return: 1700



We will hike through the dramatically shaped industrial heritage site of Mt. Nokogiri, a Boshu stone quarry ruin. First, we will ascend for 1 hour and 20 minutes to the summit of Mt. Nokogiri via the Sharikimichi trail—the historic path once used to carry stone down from the quarry. After enjoying the panoramic ocean views from the observatory, we will tackle the 1,000 stone steps leading through the grounds of Nihon-ji Temple. There is so much to see here, including a giant Buddha, a 30m/100-ft tall Kannon statue, and 1,553 distinct Rakan statues. After spending an hour exploring the temple grounds, we will descend along the Omotesando main approach for about an hour to our final destination: a former elementary school beautifully renovated into the Hota Michi-no-Eki (roadside station). There, you can enjoy shopping and try a nostalgic, Japanese school-lunch-style meal!

Mishima Skywalk & Numazu Port
Sunday, 13 September 2026
Depart: 0730 /Return: 1700

Mishima Skywalk is Japan's longest pedestrian suspension bridge, stretching 400 meters. On a clear day, you can enjoy spectacular views of Mt. Fuji, Suruga Bay, and the surrounding mountains. It is also a popular spot for walking, photography, and outdoor activities. After that, we will head to Numazu Port for lunch, Aquarium and some free time. Numazu Port is a famous fishing port known for fresh seafood, sushi, and beautiful views of Suruga Bay. There's also a unique aquarium called Numazu Deep Sea Aquarium. It is the world's first aquarium dedicated to deep-sea creatures. It features rare marine life from Suruga Bay, including the famous coelacanth, known as a "living fossil".

Mt. Fuji Hoei Crater Hiking
Saturday, 19 September 2026
Depart: 0600 /Return: 1530

Did you miss the Mt. Fuji climbing season? Why not climb Mt. Hoei instead? It is a peak on Mt. Fuji created by a major eruption during the Hoei Period (1707). We will start our hike from Mt. Fuji Fujinomiya 5th Station at an altitude of 2,400m/7,874ft, trekking through the Hoei Crater to the summit of Mt. Hoei.

The first 50 minutes will be an easy hike, followed by another 50 minutes of climbing up a crater wall covered in loose scree. Enjoy the majestic, Martian-like landscape before challenging yourself to reach the summit! From the top, you can take in panoramic views of the vast foothills, Suruga Bay, the Izu Peninsula, and more. Although it is a shorter hike with less elevation gain, you will feel the same sense of accomplishment as reaching the summit of Mt. Fuji!

***Age requirement:** 10 years and older.

***Temperature:** The temperature around the Hoei Crater in mid-September is around 10°C/50°F and can sometimes drop below 5°C/41°F. Please dress in layers.
