Snow Monkey & Matsumoto Castle

Saturday, 24 January 2026
Depart: 0430/Return: 2100

Visit Jigokudani Wild Monkey Park and enjoy this rare opportunity to observe the interesting lifestyle of Japanese macaque monkeys. Almost 200 monkeys inhabit the area and relax by bathing in the hot spring. Afterwards, we will head to Matsumoto Castle. The castle formerly named "Fukashi" was built over 400 years ago. The six-story black painted wooden keep is the oldest surviving structure in Japan and is a designated national treasure.

*Please bring or wear appropriate shoes/snow boots for a 40-minute one-way walk on the snow to the monkey park.

*Strollers cannot be used at the monkey park and inside of the castle.

*We do not guarantee that you can see bathing monkeys.

Nihondaira Hiking & Strawberry Picking

Sunday, 25 January 2026
Depart: 0530/Return: 1530



We will start hiking from Kusanagi station to Nihondaira hill. On clear days, you can observe in all 4 directions views of the plum farm, tea plantation, orange grove, Suruga Bay and Mt. Fuji! At Nihondaira hill, we will take a gondola to Mt. Kuno to visit Kunozan Toshogu Shrine, the first shrine where the primary Edo Shogunate, Tokugawa Ieyasu, was enshrined. Then we will walk down 1159 steps toward route 150, which is called "Strawberry line!" Walk on the coastline for 30 minutes to a strawberry farm to munch on strawberries as much as you want. Strawberries from this area are called "Ishigaki Ichigo," famous for its size and taste which fascinate many strawberry lovers! Afterwards, we will stop by a fish market for lunch.

Mt. Haguro Hiking

Saturday, 31 January 2026
Depart: 0500/Return: 1700



Mt. Haguro, located in "City of Gyoza", Utsunomiya, is a popular hiking trails for beginners. You can enjoy different nature beauty in all the seasons. This season, you will be able to enjoy the fragrance of wax plum blossoms while hiking. Our hike starts from Tohoku EXPWY Kamikawachi SA. Go out of the SA from the back gate and walk on the paved road for 5 minutes, we will get to the entrance of the hiking trail. Ascent for 40 minutes on the main approach to Haguoyama shrine, which is located on top of Mt. Haguro. The summit will be a couple of minutes from the shrine. If the weather is clear, you will be able to see Mt. Tsukuba, Mt. Fuji and Tokyo Skytree. Enjoy the view from the summit, then take a break at the tea house by the shrine. Descent will be about 55-minute walk through the forest. Get back to SA and try their specialty, Utsunomiya Gyoza and Kamikawachi Ramen for lunch.
