An area of 8,690ha (106 times wider than Tokvo Disneyland!), is covered with more than 300 different kinds of plants during the hiking season. This massive area stretches over three prefectures and its scenic beauty which includes marshes, ponds, ravines, forests, and mountains delights visitors. We are going to enjoy 2 days of hiking. Approximately 3 hours of hiking on the 1st day, stay and relax at the mountain hut, then 6 hours of fun hiking on the 2nd day! During this time of the year, marshes are covered with davlilies and they form the marsh into a yellow carpet. This is the best season to see various flowers at Oze. \*To conserve the nature of Oze, you cannot use shampoo, rinse/ conditioner, soap, toothpaste/mouthwash and detergent in Oze area. \*Accommodation is a mountain hut. NOT COMFORTABLE HOTEL. Room may be shared by all the hikers regardless of gender.

## Before signing up for hiking trips

Please consider your physical fitness. We do not recommend to participate in walking trips if you have knee/heart problems, asthma and any other illness.



Let's stroll the waterfront city, Mishima! It is located at the south side of the foot of Mt. Fuji and has an abundant of underflow water from the mountain. Our hike starts from a shrine where 80 red Toriis are lined up. Walk for 5 minutes in the residential area, a huge waterfall will be seen. Take photos of the waterfall and Mt. Fuji together if the weather is clear. 30 minutes from the waterfall is a Japanese garden which is designated as a natural treasure. Walk through the park and see the lava formation caused by the eruption of Mt. Fuji. Next, we will walk on a trail along Genbei River for 15 minutes. Take off your shoes and soak your feet in the limpid stream. >>>Approximately 5.6km/3.48mi, 2.5 hour walking. (Almost flat) **\*It is for ages 6 and up.** 

\*There is possibility that the trails in the river go under water in the thawing season (Summer). In that case, we will walk in the water. Wear: Comfortable shoes to walk/easy to get on/off, Short pants, Cap/hat. Bring: Rain gear, Sunscreen, Sunglasses, Marine shoes/Crocs© Sandals, Towel, Water/snacks, change of clothes, (Water bottle to bring spring water home), Yen for lunch and anything you may need. Cost: Adult (16+) \$41, Youth (10-15) \$39 (Admission, Guide, Transportation included)



Oiso Long Beach is a water park that features thrilling slides and crystalclear pools for children and adults. Sit on the floating tube boat while sliding down the 139m and 140m long slides! The park also offers a wave pool, 140-meter-long pool, a floating pool, and shallow pools for small

children. The park is perfect for families of all ages!

# Hakuba Goryu Alpine Plant Garden Saturday, 13 July 2024 Depart: 0400/Return: 1900



Hakuba Goryu, famous for its ski resort in the winter, changes its operation in the summer. From June to October, the mountain surface is covered with more than 2 million alpine plants. Take a gondola and lift to the summit where the alpine plant garden is located. There is a rare blue poppy that blooms in July and is nicknamed as the Himalayan blue poppy as it originally grows in an area of the Himalayans. In addition to seeing beautiful flowers, you will be able to enjoy a magnificent view of the Northern Japan Alps. Walk about 90 minutes around the garden, then head to the next destination, Wasabi farm. Relax and see green wasabi leaves and a beautiful spring water. Try fresh Wasabi for lunch. \**It is for all ages, however strollers cannot be used at the garden. Also, infants cannot ride a lift to summit.*

# Mt.Fuji 1<sup>st</sup> ~5<sup>th</sup> station Hiking Saturday, 20 July 2024 Depart: 0600/Return: 2000



Hike at the bottom of Mt. Fuji before attempting to summit Mt. Fuji at a different tour. We will stop by Fuji Sengen Shrine to purchase the famous Mt. Fuji hiking sticks (Kongo-zue), then move to Nakanojaya where our hike starts. First, we will walk for 80 minutes until Umagaeshi. Umagaeshi to the 3rd station is a 90-minute hike on a comfortable trail through the woods. After the 3<sup>rd</sup> station, the trail steepens where we will continue to hike for another 45 minutes until we reach the 4.5<sup>th</sup> station, which is at an altitude of 2,010m. We will hike for 50 minutes to the Yoshida 5<sup>th</sup> station and then detour for 35 minutes to the hidden 6<sup>th</sup> station to get rare stamps. We will then descend 40 minutes towards our goal, Subaru line 5<sup>th</sup> station. This tour does not include summiting Mt. Fuji but it is one of many conditioning opportunities to prepare a summit hike. Climbing stick: Y800~Y2,000 Stamps: Y300~Y500 >>>pproximately 9.3km, 5.5hour, Max elevation 1,210m

\*It is for ages 10 and up.

\*The weather on mountains can be unpredictable. Do not forget to bring rain gear.

\*Toilets are only available at the 5th stations (Y100~Y300 donation). Wear/Bring: See itinerary.
