**Nagoya Castle & Plate Painting**  
**Saturday, 06 December 2025**  
**Depart: 0500/Return: 2130**



First, we will visit Nagoya Castle, which was built at the beginning of the Edo period (1603-1868). The castle is famous for two golden tiger-headed carps on the topmost castle roof called “Shachihoko”. Afterwards, we will spend time at Osu-Kannon Temple and shopping street where you can find souvenir shops and restaurants for sightseeing and lunch. Lastly, we will visit Noritake-no-mori craft museum for plate painting.

***\*It is for ages 4 and up, however we do not recommend small children due to long bus ride.***

***\*It will take about a month to receive the plate, so please be aware if you PCS out.***

***Wear:*** Comfortable shoes and clothes to walk around.

***Bring:*** Yen for shopping and anything you may need.

***Cost:*** Adult (18+) \$83, Teen (15-17) \$79, Child (4-14) \$75

**Stroll Setagaya**  
**Saturday, 06 December 2025**  
**Depart: 0800/Return: 1630**

First, we will go through a Japanese garden at Tama River. Then walk about 20 minutes along the river towards Todoroki Stream Park. Walk on the boardwalk set along the stream, then move on to a downtown-like walk. 20 minutes from the stream park is a temple where Buddha, with blue spiral hair, is enshrined. Take photos of maple and maiden-air trees turning red and yellow. 15 minutes after, you will arrive at a shopping district that is spread in front of Jiyugaoka station. Enjoy lunch and Shopping in the area.

***Wear:*** Comfortable shoes and clothing to walk, Cap/hat.

**Chosei Sightseeing**  
**Sunday, 07 December 2025**  
**Depart: 0600/Return: 1730**

We will take you to the power spots in Chiba, to wish for good fortune in 2026! Our first stop will be Kasamori Temple. Ascend on 130 stone steps to see the 1000 years-old wooden main hall which is the only building in Japan constructed with Shihoukakezukuri architectural style. The shrine is famous for its holy black cat statues. Do not forget to get a pair for good luck, health and good relationships etc. Next, we will visit Chofukujuji Temple. The symbol of the temple, white elephants are considered to bring you big economic fortune and people wishing to win the lottery visit the temple from all over Japan! Our last destination will be the petting zoo where you can touch and feed capybaras, kangaroos, giraffes etc.

**Yushin Ravin Hiking**  
**Saturday, 13 December 2025**  
**Depart: 0600/Return: 1700**

We will hike on the trail to Yushin RaVIN, which had been closed due to landslide for a long time. Walk on the paved road for an hour, we will get to the entrance of hiking trail. After 40 minutes walking along Genkura River from the gate, we will enter the unlighted tunnels. Insides are completely dark, so do not forget to bring flashlights/head lights with you. As soon as we go through the last tunnel, amazingly clear river water will be seen. The distinctive watercolor is called “Yujin Blue”, and it fascinates hikers. The trails are in the landslide prone area; there are possibilities to close the trail sometime soon again. Do not miss this opportunity to walk the unexplored region of Tanzawa.

>>>Yushin Gorge Hiking Course: 602m/1975ft, Approximately 12.5km/7.77mi, 4.5hour, Max elevation 282m/925ft.

***\*Do not forget to bring flashlights/head lights. Recommend bringing helmet if you have.***

***\*There are no restaurants/shops along the trail. Please bring enough water/ lunch/snacks.***

***\*Tt is for ages 12 and up.***

***Wear:*** Trekking shoes, Appropriate clothing for hiking, Cap/hat.

***Bring:*** Rain gear, flashlight/head light, Sunscreen, Sunglasses, (Helmet if you have), Towel, Water/lunch/snacks, (Change of clothes), Yen for just in case.
