Our hike starts from a shrine where 80 red Toriis are lined up. Walk for 5 minutes in the residential area, a huge waterfall will be seen. Take photos of the waterfall and Mt. Fuji together if the weather is clear. 30 minutes from the waterfall is a Japanese garden which is designated as a natural treasure. Walk through the park and see the lava formation caused by the eruption of Mt. Fuji. Next, we will walk on a trail along Genbei River for 15 minutes. Take off your shoes and soak your feet in the limpid stream.

#### Mt. Fuji 1-5<sup>th</sup> station Hiking Saturday, 26 July 2025 **Depart: 0600/Return: 1700**



Hike at the bottom of Mt. Fuji before attempting to summit Mt. Fuji at a different tour. We will stop by Fuji Sengen Shrine to purchase the famous Mt. Fuji hiking sticks (Kongo-zue), then move to Nakanojaya where our hike starts. First, we will walk for 80 minutes until Umagaeshi. Umagaeshi to the 3rd station is a 90-minute hike on a comfortable trail through the woods. After the 3<sup>rd</sup> station, the trail steepens where we will continue to hike for another 45 minutes until we reach the 4.5<sup>th'</sup> station, which is at an altitude of 2,010m. We will hike for 50 minutes to the Yoshida 5<sup>th</sup> station and then detour for 35 minutes to the hidden 6<sup>th</sup> station to get rare stamps. We will then descend 40 minutes towards our goal, Subaru line 5<sup>th</sup> station. This tour does not include summiting Mt. Fuii but it is one of many conditioning opportunities to prepare a summit hike.
