Abt Railroad Hiking Sunday, 24 November 2024 Depart: 0500/Return: 1730



Railroads between Yokokawa and Karuizawa stations in Gunma were the first steam locomotive railroads running on the Abt system in 1893. To avoid running on the very steep mountain slopes, 26 tunnels and 18 bridges were constructed on the 11km railroads. In 1997, the railroads were discontinued and a part of them were renovated as the hiking trail. We will walk through two bridges, ten tunnels and the historical sites designated as important cultural properties such as the check point. After about 2 hours we will arrive at our turning point. Kumanodaira. Reverse the trail about 1km, then detour from the Abt trail to Route 18 to view a huge brickwork bridge that you crossed about an hour prior. Our goal will be Usui Pass, where you can try their specialty, CHIKAEAMOCHI (Rice cake).

Our day starts from Katsuura morning market, which has 430-year history. It began as the trading place for the fisher men and farmers. Enjoy breakfast, then stroll the serene atmosphere market street. We highly recommend to visit Tomisaki shrine where is a few minute walk from the market. Complete 60 steep steps to see magnificent Pacific Ocean from the shrine site. Our next stop, Katsuura aquarium will be underwater observation style aguarium. Go down 96-step spiral stairs to see real ocean lives; 96 kind of sea lives will be seen throughout the year. Our last excitement will be visiting scenic spot, Ubara Utopia. Stroll about one hour on the cape to enjoy beautiful view of ria coastline.

Shirakawago & Hida Takayama Saturday, 02 November 2024 Depart: 0400/Return: 2230



The remote mountain villages of gassho-style houses in Shirakawago on the hida highlands were registered as cultural heritage site in 1995. Some of the homes are over 400 years old, making the site a national treasure which holds a special place in the heart of Japan. Takayama area which has been called "Little Kyoto" Its temples, shrines, rivers and bridges are indeed reminiscent of the famed Kyoto on a smaller scale. These places are must-see tourist destinations second only to Kyoto in Japan.

Nishizawa Gorge, a part of Chichibu-Tama National Park, is located at the upper part of Fuefuki River which flows down Okushigadake Mountain. During the hike, you can see a variety of waterfalls and canyons while enjoying the natural kaleidoscopic view of the Autumn leaves. You can also enjoy the thrill of crossing a wooden bridge high above the water. The most beautiful waterfall is Nanatsugama Godan-no-taki. Cobalt blue water flows over five levels of ponds. Leaving Nishizawa, we will stop by a Mt. Fuji view *tattoo friendly* open-air hot spa.
