White Sand Beach

Let's visit Shirahama, one of the most popular beaches on mainland Japan! This 800-meter-wide white sand beach and its sky-blue ocean fascinate all visitors. Frolic in the waves, search for small crabs, splash in the water, or bask under the sun!

***Cancellation Policy:** The tour may be cancelled in case of inclement weather or rough ocean conditions.

Let's take a 25-minute ferry ride off the coast of Atami to Hatsushima island resort. This small island offers plenty of activities, including shore fishing, snorkeling, walking around the island (about 4km in circumference), napping in a hammock, flower garden, hot spring, zip lining, and tackling the obstacle course! You can also enjoy fresh seafood for lunch! Please ask ODR staff for more information.

***Cancellation Policy:** The tour may be cancelled if ferry services are suspended due to rough sea conditions.

***Getting around:** There is no public transportation on the island. The only way to get around is on foot, so please pack light.

***Tattoo Policy:** No exposed tattoos are allowed at the swimming pool or hot spring.

***Beaches:** Please note there are no sandy beaches on the island.

Attention fish lovers! Satisfy your eyes and appetite in Ibaraki Prefecture. First, we will take you to Aqua World, a stunning aquarium facing the Pacific Ocean. A major highlight is their variety of shark exhibits, where you can see more than 50 different species. Another must-see is the sunfish exhibit; due to the difficulty of rearing them, Aqua World is one of the rare places where you can see sunfish. Their popular marine animal shows are also a big hit! Next, we will visit the Nakaminato Fish Market, where you can purchase fresh seafood at affordable prices. Don't miss out on trying the steamed crab legs, grilled scallops, and raw oysters sold by local food vendors.

***Cancellation:** The event may be cancelled at short notice in case of rain.

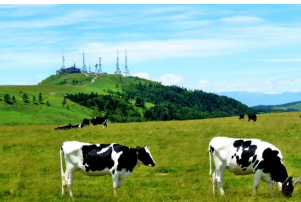
***Departure locations:** Buses depart from Camp Zama and SHA.

Utsukushigahara Hiking
Saturday, 29 August 2026
Depart: 0500/Return: 1830



Let's hike Utsukushigahara, the stunning plateau that spreads above the clouds! Our hike starts from Yamamoto hut. We will walk for 70 minutes through a vast pasture until we get to the highest point on the plateau, Ogatou. Another 20 minutes from Ohatou takes us to the edge of the plateau, Ogahana. If the weather is clear, you can expect dynamic views of the Northern Japan Alps. Enjoy unique geological formations, cute alpine flowers, and the balmy breeze before a 2-hour walk to the Yamamoto hut via Eboshi Rock.

◆Distance: 10km/6.2mi

◆Duration: Approximately 3.5 hour (Brak time excluded)

◆Elevation gain: 305m/1,001ft.

***Age requirement:** 10years and older.

***Abandon:** Weather on high-altitude plateaus can be unpredictable.

Please note that no refunds will be given if the hike cannot be completed due to a sudden change in weather.

***Temperature:** The average temperature in August at Utsukushigahara is around 13°C/55°F. Please bring extra layers and proper hiking gear.
