# Pet Care Center Boarding Information



We are quarantine and general boarding facility that caters mostly to Camp Zama soldiers, civilians, and retiree personnel on TDY, leave, or emergency status. We also try to support other local base residents as much as possible.

We have 17 active dog kennels with adjacent kenneling runs that lead to an open air and concreted walkway for dogs to lounge and enjoy the atmosphere. We interact and play with dogs daily to keep their spirits up while you are away. Our cattery is large and spacious, with double wide metal kennels and two specially crafted double wide cages cats designed to give comfort and quiet areas. Cats are not allowed to free roam unsupervised, however we allow for floor time to stretch their legs and muscles daily.

Our facility has no open area/walking trek for dog walking. You are allowed to visit your animals any time we are open, and encourage visits longer than 15-20 minutes if possible. Owners are welcome to walk dogs, but please have them back at our facility at least 30 minutes prior to closing for the day. Cats are not encouraged to be taken out of the facility.

# **Boarding/Grooming Requirements:**

We require both dogs and cats to receive full and adequate immunization requirements for their services at the Camp Zama Pet Care Center. We will need to see proof of the following for adult dogs/cats (young animals have additional requirements):

Dogs- Rabies, DA2PP, & Bordetella vaccines. Rabies and Bordetella are yearly vaccines. DA2PP is given every 3 years for adult dogs.

Cats- Rabies and FVRCP vaccines done every 3 years for adult cats. We also require a yearly negative FeLV/FIV blood screening. We cannot board cats that test positive for these conditions.

Both species are required to be flea/tick & internal parasite free. Pets must be well behaved, nonaggressive, and without any major medical or behavioral conditions in order to stay with us.

### What To Bring:

We do not provide food at our facility! We do provide all other living essentials for both cats and dogs, however owners are allowed to bring anything to make their pets more comfortable while in our care. Please bring full feeding portions + two days extra per pet. You are welcome to bring bedding, sheets, towels, mats, etc for your pet's comfort, however we don't recommend anything of sentimental value as sometimes pets are destructive when stressed. Toys are permitted if pets are non-destructive.

# **Grooming Information:**

We have a small but dedicated grooming program available to the community. As of right now, we only have one groomer named Ms Wadasan and she handles all grooming for our facility. We do daily grooming Monday-Thursday. Giant breeds may not be accommodated by our small team. Pets that are scheduled for grooming are dropped off at allotted times. We will call you upon completion of services. Please be in the immediate area for pick up.

# PCS In / Out Support

Our facility supports those in PCS in/out transition as much as possible, but we have limitations on requests due to staffing and procedure changes since Covid-19. We will need to see flight confirmation, immunization records, and our boarding documents completed prior to your reservation confirmation. Our reservation and abilities book up fast, so please get in contact with us as soon as possible to begin processing.









Please consider your pets overall wellbeing. We do not recommend to board elderly, under a year, or pets with severe anxiety as these pets tend to do poorly in unfamiliar situations.
