Mt. Fuji Ochudo Hiking Sunday, 05 October 2025 Depart: 0500/Return: 1430



Did you miss Mt. Fuji climbing season this year? No worry, still have an option to hike on Mt. Fuji! Join us for the short hike, the Ochudo Trail! Ochudo used to be the holy trail circle around 5th stations, only allowed for people who had climbed Mt. Fuji more than three times. Now it is open for everyone to walk, but only a part of the ancient trail is accessible due to landslides. We will hike from the Subaru line 5th station through Oniwa area to the hidden beautiful spot Okuniwa. Enjoy viewing KOYO (leaves turning red, yellow and orange), bird watching and tasty autumn local foods.

Yanesen Walking Saturday, 11 October 2025 Depart: 0900/Return: 1800



Let's stroll around the Yanesen area to look for nostalgic sights and delicious foods. Yanesen is a generic name of Yanaka, Nezu and Sendagi town in Tokyo. They developed as temple district, temple town and Samurai residence. Many wooden architectures built in Edo ~Showa period still exist in this area. During the walk, you will have a chance to see/shoot ancient buildings, which are renovated and reused as shops, cafes, museums etc. Next, we will visit one of the most popular SHOTENGAI (shopping street) to enjoy TABEARUKI (munching local foods while strolling) and purchasing traditional Japanese products. The shopping street is also well known as the town of cats. You can find many cat motif goods/ foods. Cat statues set on the roof and perhaps real cats napping on the street. Our

goal will be the symbol of Nezu town, Nezu Shrine. On the tour day, the annual downtown festival will be held around the area and the shrine will be the main festival site. Enjoy many kinds of performances and something from food venders. >>>Approximately 4.5km/2.8mi walking.

The style of the festival is deeply influenced by the Edo Tenka Festival and began to feature the pulling of spectacular festival floats. Enjoy the festive atmosphere with food and drinks!

Takasaki Sightseeing Sunday, 26 October 2025 Depart: 0700/Return: 1730





Our first destination will be Syorin Daruma Temple. True to its name, various sizes of Daruma dolls, which is the charm for good luck and wish, are displayed in the temple site. After strolling the unique temple site, we will try daruma doll painting. Decorate the dolls with your favorite color and design. Next, we will stop by the symbol of Takasaki, Takasaki Kannon Temple. A 41m tall Kannon statue was built in 1936 as the memorial service for war victims. Climb up 150 steps set inside of the statue to observe the entire Kanto plain. Our last stop will be a number one scale Japanese garden in Northern Kanto area, where fascinates visitors with its seasonal scene. Do not forget to shoot Japanese autumn beaty.
