Shosenkyo Hiking Saturday, 03 May 2025 **Depart: 0630/Return: 1630**



Let's walk through the most beautiful gorge in Japan, Shosenkyo! Due to its amazing scenery and abundant clarity, Shosehkyo Gorge has been designated as Japan Heritage! Beginning of the hike, you will be able to see unique-shaped rocks along Arakawa River. Walk about 30 minutes and you will get to Tenkorin woods. By stomping firmly on the ground, you might be able to hear echoes emanating from underground, a natural phenomenon. 40 minutes from Tenkorin, you will pass through a naturally formed stone gate. The highlight of the gorge, the Sengataki Waterfall, is a few minutes from the stone gate. Climb 180 steps and you will arrive at the Crystal Street where we will enjoy lunch and free time. You'll have the opportunity to ride a gondola, visit museums, taste wine and crystal hunting. Afterwards, we will head to Kanazakura Shrine to admire rare cherry blossom, Ukon Zakura, which is the only cherry blossom blooms vellow flowers. >>>Shosenkyo Trail: Approximately 5km, 1.5 hour hiking

Nezame-no-Toko & Magomejuku Saturday, 10 May 2025 Depart: 0600/Return: 2130



Nezame-no-toko located in Nagano prefecture, it literally means "wake-up bed". It is a bed of rocks at an enchanting location along the Kiso river, known for its fascinating rock formations and its beautiful emerald green color water. Our net stop is Magomejuku. Where during Edo period there were five roadways that connected to Edo (Tokyo) and outlying regions. The Nakasendo road linked Edo and Kyoto which ran through central Japan. It has 69 posting stations of which Magome-juku was the 43rd. Walking through Magome-juku will transport you back to Edo period. Enjoy the local food and get some souvenirs as well! *Short walking involved.

All three are located inside the shrine's complex. We will also visit Chuzenji Lake, Kegon Waterfall and Ryuzu Waterfall.

Fujino Art Road Walking & Pottery Festival JEN Saturday, 17 May 2025 **Depart: 0700** /**Return: 1530**



The Fujino area, where is a part of Sagamihara City, is well known as an "art sanctuary". Artists have displayed 30 of their open-air masterpieces. You will be able to find them on our hike. The symbol of Fujino town, "Midori-no-Love letter" artwork can be seen from hiking start point. The first 20 minutes contains gentle ups and downs, followed by a 20-minute steep uphill trek. The rest of the course will be almost flat or downhill. After 2 hours of hiking, we will visit Fujino Pottery Festival site. Find out your favorite pottery and get lunch from food vendors. >>>Art Hiking Course: approximately 7.6km/4.72mi, 2-hour hiking, Max elevation 130m/426ft.

Izu Panorama Park & Mito Sea Paradise **Sunday, 18 May 2025 Depart: 0700/Return:1730**



Our first destination is Izu Panorama Park. We will take a ropeway to the top where you can enjoy the beautiful view of ocean, Mt. Fuji and Izu area. The reflection of Mt. Fuji on the water is so beautiful! There is a café, foot bath and little park for kids. After that we will have a lunch break. After lunch, we will go to Mito Sea paradise. Enjoy watching sea animals such as dolphins, sea lions, fur seals, walrus, penguins, and other fish!

Nishizawa Gorge Hiking Sunday, 25 May 2025 Depart: 0500/Řeturn: 1900



Nishizawa Gorge, a part of Chichibu-Tama National Park, is located at the upper part of Fuefuki River which flows down Okushigadake Mountain. During the hike, you can see a variety of waterfalls and canyons while enjoying the natural kaleidoscopic view of the vibrant green leaves. You can also enjoy the thrill of crossing a wooden bridge high above the water. The most beautiful waterfall is Nanatsugama Godan-no-taki. Cobalt blue water flows over five levels of ponds. Leaving Nishizawa, we will stop by a Mt. Fuji view tattoo friendly open-air hot
